

Greetings Friday Senior Men's League Member,

We are thrilled to be open for business! It's been a busy few days as we are learning how to function under a "new normal". We are so excited to be able to offer league play. We have modifications in place in order to abide by current regulations and to make sure our customers are as safe as possible.

Please read below for all the details on what you can expect with our "new normal":

Course Set-Up

We have removed benches and ball washers until further notice. Golf cups have foam inserts so that the ball does not drop completely in the hole. You can easily grab your golf ball with your fingertips.

Schedule

May 8 - October 2 (21 weeks)

No banquet fee at this time. If we are allowed to do a banquet by the end of the year, we will consider and revisit this as an option.

Fee: \$358 (Includes 21 weeks of golf and \$21 prize pool)

Optional Discounted Executive Pass: \$22.00 (Normally \$209)

Executive Pass gives you discounted golf when you play outside of the league (\$6 at Applewood, \$5 at Gem Lake, \$4 at Oak Glen Exec.)

*Payment on our website is preferred to avoid a large lineup at the golf course.

Pre-Round

We are not allowed to have groups of people congregating, so please avoid arriving extremely early and just plan to arrive roughly 10-15 minutes prior to your tee time. This will help eliminate the possibility of traffic build-up.

Events

The events will be modified for the time being to exclude events that have proximity markers on the course. This is in order to follow guidelines that have us removing "touch points" from the course.

Food/Beverage Sales

We will offer beverage service pre-round. No beverage service is available post-round for the time being. To begin, available beverages will include bottled soft drinks, water, and canned beer/products. Our bartender will grab your beverage and place it on a table for you to grab. You will swipe your own credit card to complete the transaction.

Merchandise Sales

We have limited merchandise, but will offer this as well. Golf balls, tees, gloves, hats, visors can be purchased in the golf shop. Our staff will place the merchandise on a table for you to grab. You will swipe your own credit card to complete the transaction.

Bathrooms

Bathrooms are available for use. We are doing our best to disinfect periodically throughout the day. We also plan to have the portable bathrooms available on the course. We will disinfect these at least once per day. If you use these, please use hand sanitizer as you exit.

Carts/Pull Carts

Both pull carts and riding carts are available. We are allowed to have just one rider in each cart (unless you live in the same household). This will make things a little more challenging as more carts on the course means less carts generally available. So if you can walk, or you are a sometimes walker/sometimes rider, we ask that you choose walking until we can put two riders in a cart. So carts are available but will potentially be limited. We will be disinfecting carts before and after use for your safety.

Post Round

We are not allowed to have congregating of groups. After your round, we ask you to leave promptly. We look forward to the day we can hang out together inside for socializing!

As the season progresses, we may see some of the regulations in place lifted or eased. If this is the case, we will communicate that to you right away. As we have all learned over the past couple of months, flexibility is important as things can change so quickly.

To the best of our abilities, we have laid out what the (current) plans are for the season ahead. We respect the fact that this unique set of circumstances is impacting everyone in varying ways. If you cannot play this year due to any reason (financial, health, fear, etc.) please let us know so that we can plan accordingly.

To those of you who are able to hang with us and play this season, we are extremely grateful for your business. We look forward to doing our very best to make this season a fun one, and a chance for you to “escape” the stress and anxiety so many of you have felt over recent times.
